Brindabella hills	Brindabella Hills Winery sits high above the Murrumbidgee River, offering breathtaking views alongside their cool-climate wines. Founded by Dr. Roger Harris, this boutique winery is known for its elegant Shiraz and Riesling, with each vintage reflecting the beauty of its surrounds. The peaceful setting makes it an ideal spot for long lunches and wine tastings.
Shaw Estate	Shaw Estate is set against the backdrop of the stunning Murrumbateman landscape, the contemporary tasting room offers panoramic views of the Estate. Guests can enjoy guided tastings led by knowledgeable staff, who share insights into the winemaking process and the unique characteristics of each wine.
Surveyors Hill	Surveyors Hill Vineyards is a family-run winery nestled on the slopes of an ancient volcano near Hall. The unique geology and elevation contribute to wines with structure and complexity, particularly their bold reds and vibrant whites. Focused on site-driven expressions, Nick crafts standout Riesling and Shiraz from premium Canberra District vineyards. McKellar Ridge Wines	McKellar Ridge Wines is known for its handcrafted cool-climate wines. Run by husband and wife team John and Marina Sekoranja, the winery blends tradition with a passion for minimal intervention winemaking. You might even get the chance to peek at the wine making behind the scenes.
Eden Road Wines	Eden Road Wines offers a diverse selection of cool-climate wines, emphasizing terroir expression. Their seated tastings, complemented by cheese platters, provide an intimate experience for guests seeking quality and authenticity.
Murrumbateman Winery	Murrumbateman Winery is a small business run by owner and winemaker, Bobbie Makin. He is well known for using less common grape varieties to make quality cool climate wines. He enjoys using traditional methods and creativity to produce small batch, award-winning wines. Their friendly cellar door is a welcoming spot for all.
Pankhurst Wines	Pankhurst Wines is a family-owned winery where every bottle is made with hands-on care. Established in the 1980s by Allan and Christine Pankhurst, the vineyard is one of the district's oldest. Their small-batch wines, especially the Pinot Noir and Chardonnay, reflect decades of passion and dedication to Canberra's wine region.
The Vintners Daughter	The Vintners Daughter is led by Steph Helm and Ben Osborne, who oversee every aspect of production from vine to bottle, continuing a family tradition with a modern, sustainable approach. The winery's portfolio includes innovative blends including the perfect Canberra rosé.

- ✓ An easy way to build out your day is to choose a lunch stop first, and then other wineries that fit your vibe.
- ✓ Our tours offer a maximum of four stops including lunch. For a slower paced day choose three stops including lunch.
- ✓ For very large groups, it can be best to split the group in half so you can enjoy stops with lower capacity. Choose four stops as usual and we will arrange the rest. It's nice to come together as a big group for lunch, so make sure the lunch stop can cater to your group. If your group is larger than 40, please get in touch about alternative options.
